

Expedited Fees

Frequently Asked Questions

Here are some answers to questions we receive frequently from the public about expedited fees. We provide this for informational purposes only. It does not constitute legal advice.

1. Why are there expedited fees?

Expedited fees are used to ensure a filing occurs on a specific date.

2. What are the expedited fees?

Expedited Method	Fee	Restrictions
Same Day Filing	\$200	Submit before 12 Noon
24 Hour Filing	\$100	

3. Can I expedite a filing after I submit the document?

No, you submit the expedited request at the same time the document is submitted for filing.

4. I want to do an online filing. Can I expedite a document if I upload and submit the document online?

Yes, if you ask for expedited status when you upload your document. However, there are some restrictions that apply when you file a document online and ask for expedited status.

Expedited Filing Type	Online Submission Restrictions
Same Day Filing	Available if we receive the online filing before 12 Noon each business day.
24 Hour Filing	If we received an online filing after 5 p.m., it is treated as received on the next business day at 8 a.m.

5. I want to expedite a document. When does the expedited process begin?

The expedited process begins when the document is received in our office. If you have used FedEx, UPS, or Priority Mail and are tracking your documents, the 24 hour or same day service begins when the document is received at our physical location.
