I'm certain that there are other occupations that require hundreds of notarizations between a specific notary and a specific signor.

Perhaps there would be a way to as a Notary, "register" a common notary subject. For example, my paralegals Tameeka, Tammy, and Stephanie could list me as a specific individual that wouldn't require a log entry.

It wouldn't apply to any non-registered individual. That would be fair game.

Another idea would to have a notary app where they notary opened the app and took a photo of the document which would be uploaded to a database. Data entry by the notary would need to be close to nothing. But, if something came up, there would be a record with notary name, date and time.
