

Be aware that registering securities and filing reports with the SEC does not automatically mean the company will be a good investment.

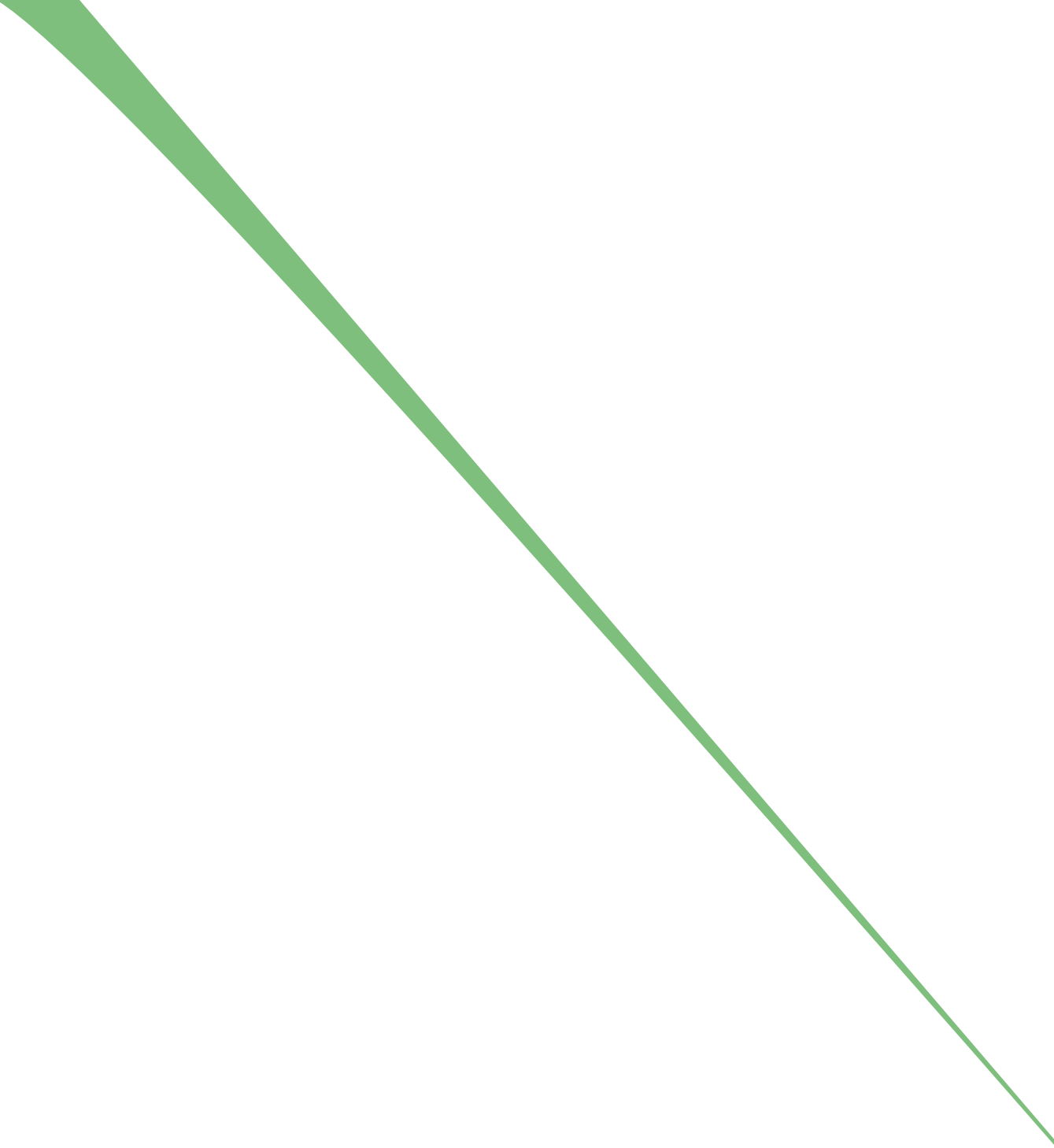
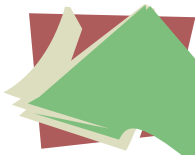
